Notes

The difficulty level of the parts is approximately as follows: Vn I - Grade 4-5, Vn II - Gr.3-4, Vn III - Gr.1, Va - Gr.2-3, Vcl I - Gr.1-2, Vcl II - Gr.1, DB - Gr.2-3, DB II - Gr.1-2. Vn III and Vcl/DB II are not necessary to complete the texture except in Vn III bar 89, when the two notes are cued in the 2nd Vn part. They can omitted altogether if not practical. In the Vcl/DB II part in the score, the small notes indicate the DB line where it is necessary or desirable to play different notes. (Usually an octave higher.)

If the 'hooked' bowing is found to be too difficult the notes can be play with separate bows, trying where possible to keep the down-bow on the beat.
